Jesus came to bring us

- 2. How does Jesus' life and death compare to the parable of the seed? How does it compare to our own lives? (**John 4:34**, Matthew 26:39, John 5:30, Luke 2:49, Hebrews 10:5-7, Mark 10:45, **John 10:17-18**, Philippians 2:9-11)
- 3. How does this understanding get rid of our fear of death? What does death bring to the life of a Christian? (Ecclesiastes 9:5-6, Romans 6:3-5, **Matthew 10:28-31**, I Peter 3:14, John 5:24, John 8:51, John 11:25-26, **Psalms 23:4**, Hebrews 13:5)
