2nd Sunday Night Shindig!

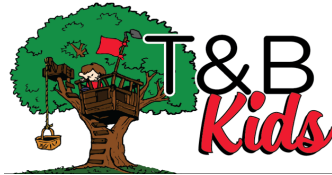
T&B's Homemade Ice Cream Contest is
