All Ladies are invited to a swim party at the home of Lisa McGee on Monday, August 2 from 6-8:00 p.m. Come and enjoy being together!

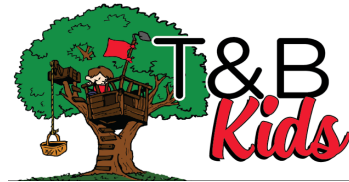
