Each class contains great Bible teaching, but our focus is learning together, playing together and sharing. Our preschool program involves children 2 years to PreK, currently led by Christina Honig. Our K-3rd graders are taught by Bonnie Stanford. Finally, Greg Stanford leads Club 456, our 4th-6th grade program. Club 456 gives preteens a place all their own. The group engages in Bible discussions and life applications along with fun games and activities. Each of these programs give kids a chance to learn and explore what they believe while having a place to belong.



Sunday Morning: Join us for youth group time (7th-12th Grade) every Sunday morning immediately following worship in the youth wing as we study through the Bible looking at how every story points to Jesus.

Wednesday Night: Every Wednesday night from 7-8 p.m. in the youth wing, we come together to play games, encourage and pray for one another in our youth small groups, and discover what it looks like to follow Jesus.
