Men's Conference @ The Hills Church

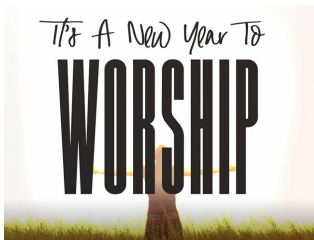
January 27th-28th

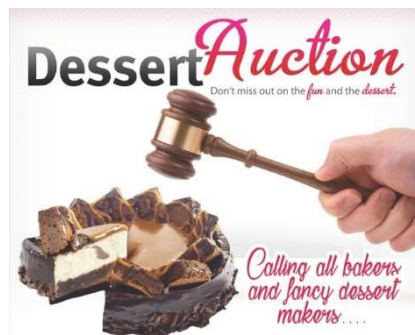
