

What do I need to know?

WHAT is AWAKEN? AWAKEN is a movement of prayer and fasting focused on unifying the church to strategically pray for and bless Wichita Falls, one person at a time WHEN is it? *It begins Tuesday, February 1st-Wednesday, March 2.*

WHERE is it? This month-long journey of prayer and fasting will take place wherever you are located day-in and day-out. This is not about a big event; rather it is about mobilizing the church to pray for and bless our city in all of the places we live, work, and play each day. In addition to our personal and family prayer times, there will be special opportunities to gather with others to pray.

HOW can I participate? Simply follow the instructions provided in the AWAKEN packets WHAT is in the packet*? A short book on fasting entitled "*Revival Starts Here*."

What are my next steps?

2. Prepare (see pages 49-51 of *Revival Starts Here*).

3. Fill out the prayer card located in your AWAKEN packet with the names of the households in Wichita Falls that you have been provided with.

DURING the fast:

1. Set your heart on God each day using the daily prayer guide, *Jesus Next Door*.

- 2. Pray and fast for the people on your list each day.
- 3. Make life better for the people on your prayer list.

*The AWAKEN packets are available in the Atrium today. If you still have your books from last year, you can purchase a folder for \$5 that <u>includes the 15 households in Wichita Falls you will be praying for</u>. If you do not have the books, you can purchase a full packet for \$10.
