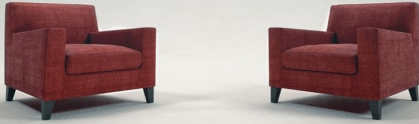

Youth and Parent Meeting: Immediately following classes on Wednesday, August 31, we will have a brief meeting for the youth group and their parents in the youth building to discuss upcoming events for the fall semester.

The *Freedom in Christ Course* is a 12-week long, video-based discipleship course designed to help every Christian break free from what is holding them back and become who they are made to be in Christ. It is for every Christian—from those who have been Christians for a long time to those who are brand-new followers of Jesus. Unlike many Christian discipleship courses today, the focus of this course is not on how to behave, but on what to believe.

Ken Holsberry will facilitate this course. Participants will be expected to buy their course materials through the registration form, do the weekly homework, and attend each weekly meeting to discuss their observations.

The course will be limited to the first 12 people to register and purchase the book at a cost of \$10. (Use link to register and purchase the book.) The course begins Wednesday, September 7, 7:00 p.m. Each session will meet at The Corner, next to the Tenth and Broad Church of Christ.
