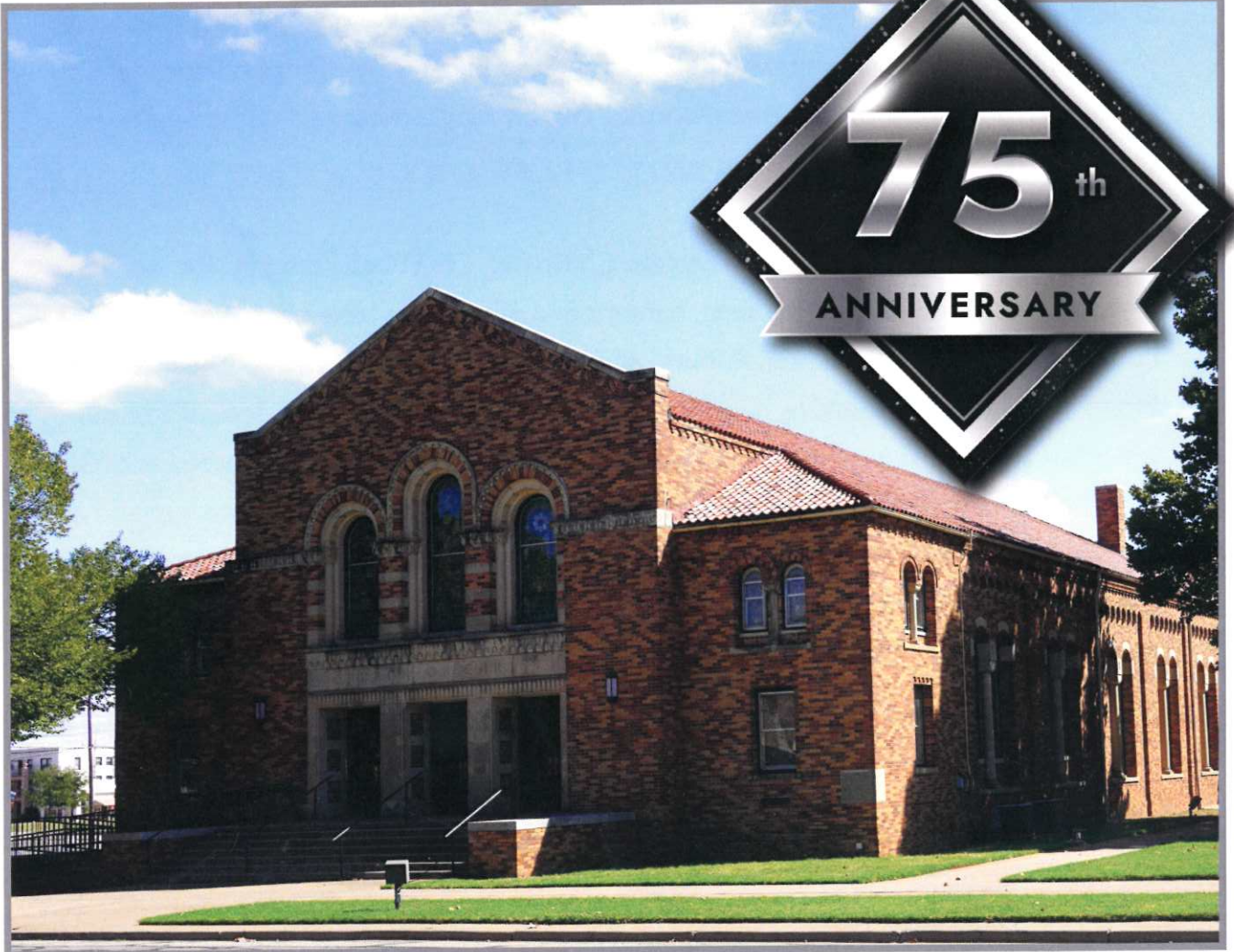

Church of Christ

On July of 1947, the Tenth and Austin Streets Church of Christ broke ground for the construction of a new church home. After fifteen months of building, a new structure was completed at the corner of Tenth and Broad Streets. Of Romanesque architecture, the new beautiful building was constructed of steel and brick, trimmed with stone, with a red tile roof and beautiful art glass windows. For its time, the new building was completely modern in every way, with indirect lighting and central heating and cooling. On the cornerstone were written these words, "This building is dedicated to the teaching of the gospel as taught by Jesus Christ and His apostles."

For 75 years the Tenth and Broad Streets Church of Christ has stood at this location. Over the years, the educational wing, nursery, and office areas have been renovated and relocated. A Family Life Center, Atrium, and covered-drive entrance have been added. Most recently, a Youth Building has been constructed. In all of the work, special attention was given to maintaining the architectural integrity of this beautiful and impressive building. We gather today to recognize this building's use as a tool for God's kingdom and as a sending-point for 75 years of missions, continuing to be dedicated to the teaching of the gospel as taught by Jesus Christ and His apostles.
