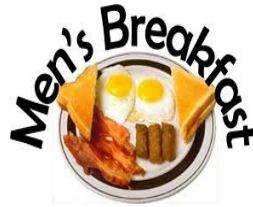
The **All-Church Christmas Party** is NEXT Sunday, December 8! Everyone is asked to bring 2 dozen of their favorite finger foods.
