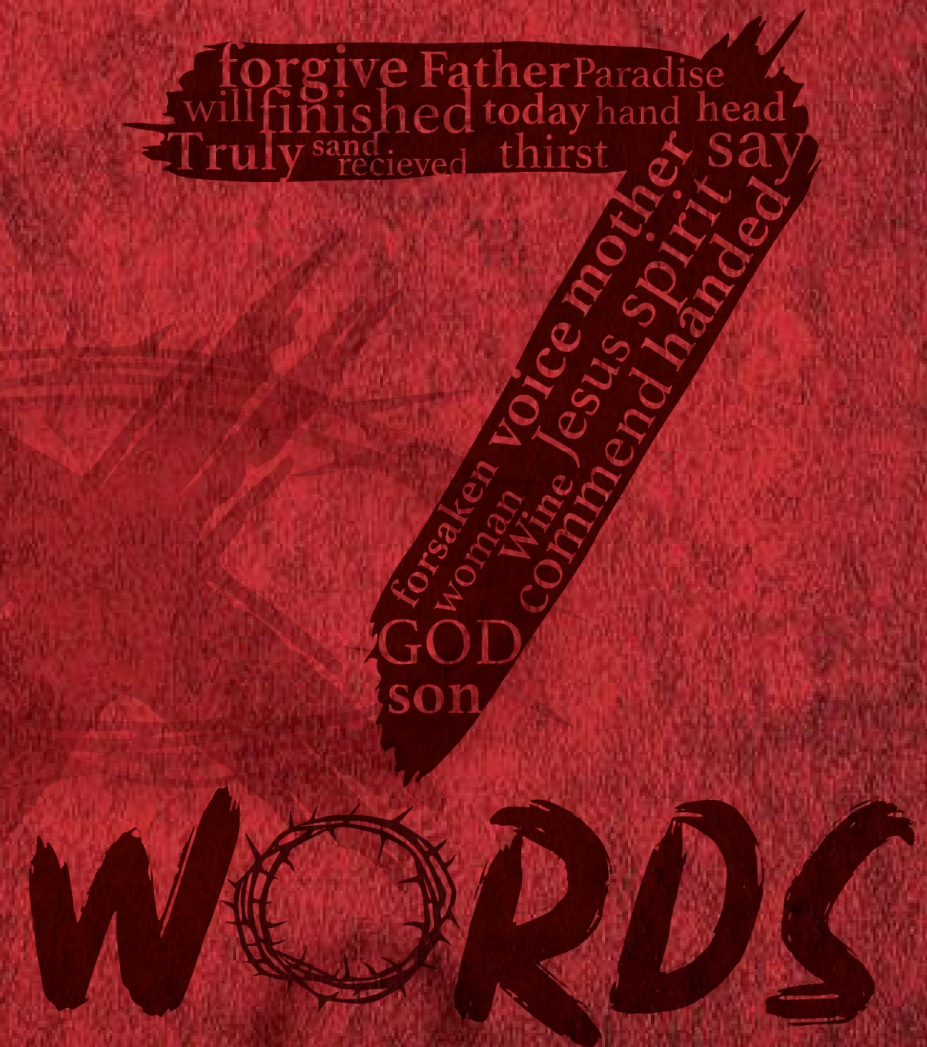

be speaking. All men are invited!

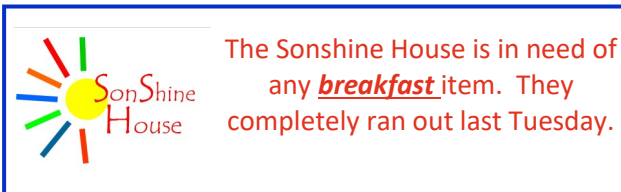
