Volunteers are always needed to keep Refuel Café up and running so let Debbie Nelson know if you can help in this way.

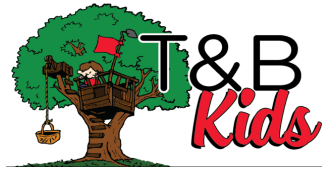
