As students seek for belonging and connection, we provide for them a loving community where they can form meaningful relationships that help them grow in their faith. Tenth and Broad is located in the city of Wichita Falls in north central Texas just 15 miles south of the Oklahoma border. The area has much to offer, including:

Summary

Qualifications

- Oversee the Campus Ministry building on the campus of MSU.
- Work with the ministry staff team to contribute and enhance all the goals and plans of the Tenth and Broad church.
- Build and maintain good relationships with other local churches that support the ministry.

Reporting Relationships

All ministers at Tenth and Broad are part of a ministry team that works together for the betterment of the Tenth and Broad family under the oversight of the elders. The Campus Minister serves as a part of the church staff and attends weekly and monthly meetings. They are responsible for communicating with church staff and Elders about their ministries needs.
